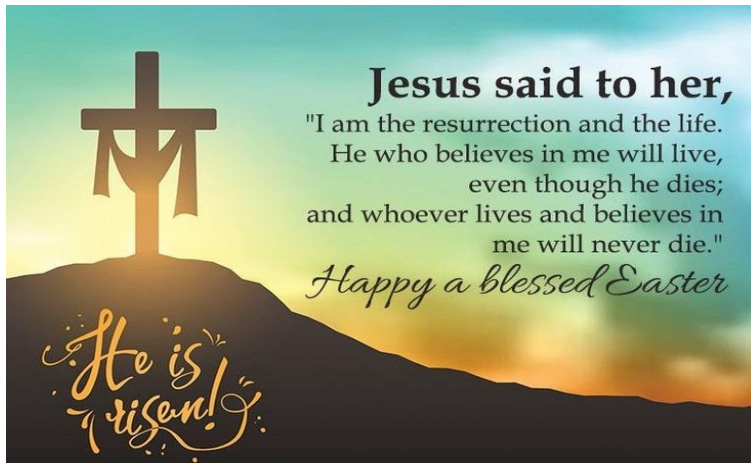

They will miss over **2 years** of school by graduation.

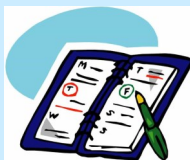

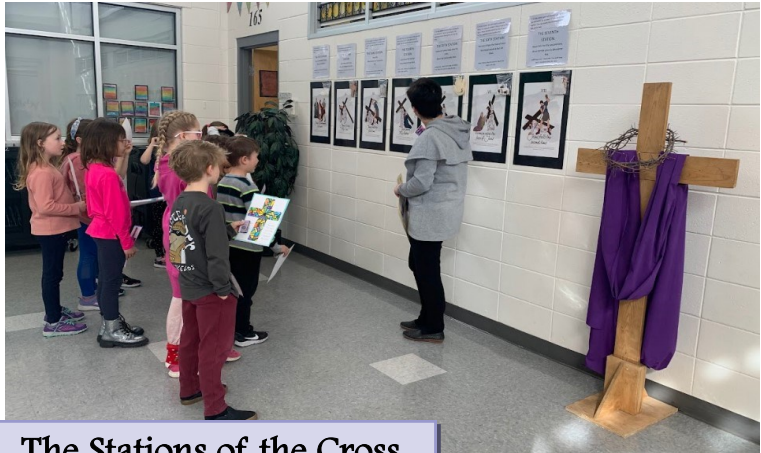
