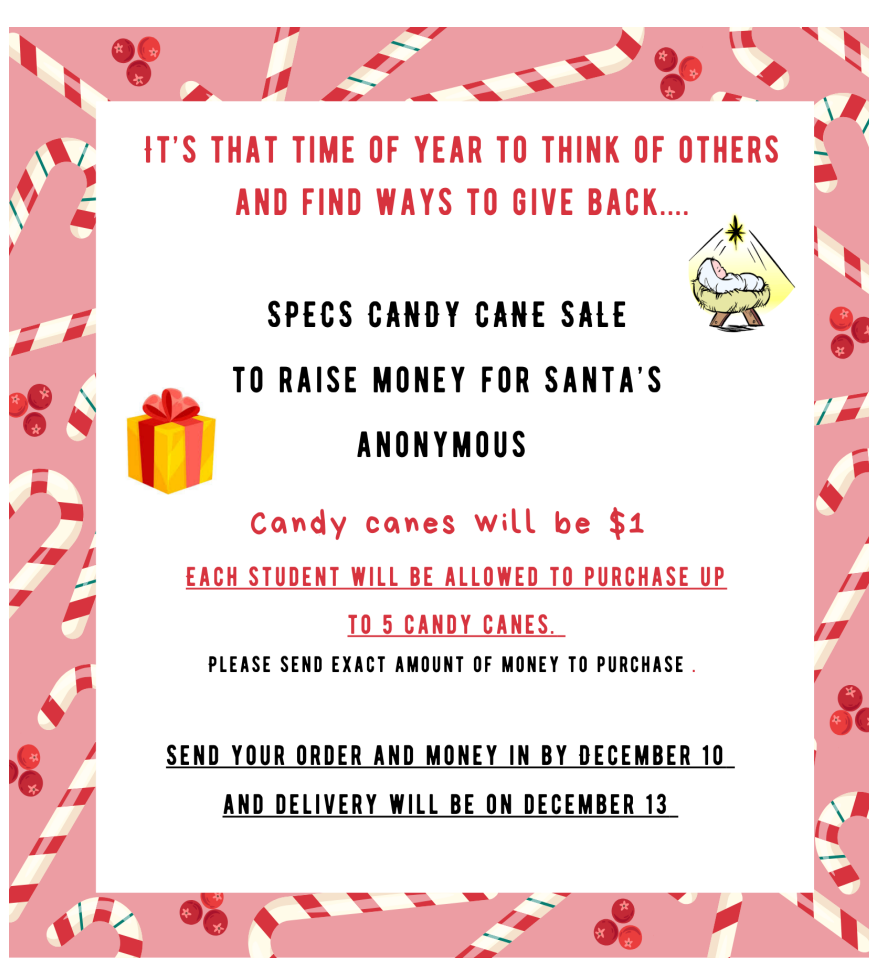

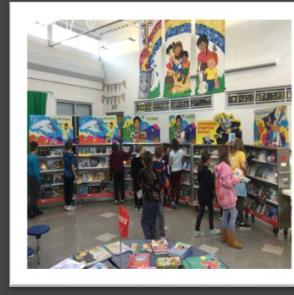
Learning Commons
